KS4 Futures is for students to follow the Cranbury College Core Curriculum, plus personalised options that enable them to gain the qualifications, skills and experience needed to be successful in:

1. the world of work,
2. financial independence, and
3. making a positive contribution to society.

Academic, Pastoral, and Career staff, work with AP and WEX partners to help them chose an educational; trade; or career pathway.

Student programmes of study are tailored to support them in preparing and making the first steps towards achieving their future goals.

Students in YR 9/10, who are able and want to take that pathway, are supported to return to mainstream school.

We use various agencies to assist our students in removing barriers to progression and life planning, including:

- No 5 Counsellor
- Mental Health and EP surgeries, to ensure removal of barriers to learning.
- Business Mentors/ Alumni/ Adviza/ Starting Point/ Get Berkshire Active/ Army working with students to support Work Readiness Curriculum
- Youth Service/ Prison visits to support with PSHE/ Social and Emotional Development
- Visits to Post 16 provisions/ apprenticeship placements
- Financial Education to prepare students for
- Support applying for jobs/ Post 16 provision/ CV writing/ interview techniques
