

Cranbury College - Key Stage 3 Phase

KS3 at Cranbury College provides education for years 7, 8 and 9, with year 9 students transitioning to the KS4 Phase at a time that suits the individual student and their personal educational pathway.

To enable change in behaviour, and confidence in learning, we offer an holistic child-centred curriculum, based on the Core (English, Maths, Science and IT) plus other subjects.

We use topic based cross-curricular themes to provide a sound learning platform.

Termly reviews are used to decide any interventions and next steps, which may include:

- an application to a mainstream school,
- in-house support e.g. 1:1 learning interventions,
- AP including:
 - Autoskills
 - Woodwork
- SEMH and CBT

A key principle focus is the nurture aspect required to enable confidence in learning and the social management of school life.
