



## **EXAMS UPDATE/TEACHER ASSESSED GRADES 2020/21**

Dear Parent/Carer

We hope this update finds you and your family safe and well.

We thought it would be helpful to tell you about our plans for Year 11 qualification grades as promptly and clearly as possible.

As you will already know, this year's GCSE and A Level exams season has been cancelled because of the Covid-19 pandemic.

There is no doubt this decision will have been causing worry for young people and their families because of uncertainty about what process will be used to replace the cancelled exams.

To be clear and straightforward, our commitment to every one of the young people in our care is that they will receive a fair grade across their exam subjects, and equally, they will not be disadvantaged by the change to the normal exam arrangements.

Senior Leaders and subject teachers from Cranbury College and Hamilton School will be working together to collate assessment information and professionally moderate the grades awarded as a result of this process. There will be a standardised and robust series of checks at each stage of this procedure in order to achieve the following objectives:

- The system is fair and consistent for all young people at Cranbury College and Hamilton School.
- Senior Leaders and Subject teachers at Cranbury College and Hamilton School will have confidence in the process.
- Exam board submission deadlines are met. (18<sup>th</sup> June 2021)
