## Next Steps at Cranbury

An update from our Headteacher, Miss Burns

I am writing to update you on the progress and changes in place for Cranbury College and the plan for the next academic year.

As a team, we believe Cranbury College has a significant impact on the young people in our community who struggle to access mainstream education, for a variety of reasons. We have worked hard this year in trying to improve our provision for our students who attend. We are now able to update you on a number of areas, which we feel very proud of, and some of these changes we have found parental feedback and consultations to be pivotal in helping change some key elements.

### **New Secondary Student Uniforms**

As of September, all young people attending Cranbury College will wear a new school uniform. This comprises of a white polo shirt with a small, embroidered orange 'C', and a black round neck polo jumper with a small embroidered 'C'. Further information on uniform and expected appearance can be found in our Uniform Policy (Page 7) <u>here.</u> We thank you for your replies to our consultation and we are\_pleased that the majority of parents and carers were in favour of a uniform.
