
Primary Outreach

Cranbury Primary Behaviour Outreach service works with Reading mainstream primary schools and academies to support students with their Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) needs, which may compromise their learning and /or the learning of their peers.

Our Aims

- Remove barriers to learning
- Empower schools and parents
- To reduce the number of students at risk of exclusion.
- To support schools to reduce suspensions.

'Cranbury Engaged' is our bolt-on intervention offer which can be accessed within Tier 1 and 2 support for an individual student.

We provide early, targeted support for children who do not currently have Education, Health and Care plans (EHCP).

Cranbury Engaged and Reset will have a cost for schools and are not included in School's Forum.


Schools and academies, which do not contribute to School's Forum, are required to pay for Tier 1, 2 and 3, packages.

Our Packages

'Core' Package



- Initial meeting with key stakeholders
- Observation of pupil in school and around peers
- Summary report with suggested strategies
- Report feedback and planning meeting
- Review meeting (check in)

(Included in schools forum)

'Enhanced' Package



- Initial meeting with key stakeholders
- Observations/Assessment of student in class and around peers
- Report outlining next steps and strategies: if appropriate Anxiety Analysis and Therapeutic Tree completed
- OSW will work in the classroom/ with key adults to model and embed strategies
- Review meetings (Check-in)
- Attend TAC/F CIN/EP meetings within term of involvement

Cranbury 'Engaged'

Behaviour Outreach Support Officers can provide either 1:1 or small group interventions.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Draw and Talk
- ELSA
- Lego Therapy
- Self-identity and self esteem
- Anger Management
- Social Skills

(Intervention offer to local schools)

The 'Reset' and Cranbury 'Engaged' packages will be accessible from Spring 2024.

'Reset' Package



- In reach within Cranbury Primary Alternative Provision
- Students can attend either an AM or PM session
- Minimum of 6 weeks and maximum of 12 weeks
- Assessment and Intervention report
- Support students back into mainstream
- Mid way review with school and parents

(Only accessible if engaged in Tier 2 level package)

Our Referral Process

Before a referral can be made to the Outreach Team, there must be evidence of the 'Early Prognosis Tool' completed.

Complete the referral and submit the appropriate paperwork.

Once the referral has been received there will be a consultation meeting to identify the appropriate package.

Enhanced package can only be accessed after engagement in the Reset package (tier 2).
