Year 11 GCSE Results Day 2024

Results Day – Thursday 22 August

Students are welcome on site to collect results from 10:00am-12:00pm on Thursday 22 August. If they would like their results collected by someone else on their behalf, emailed to an email address or they would like their results posted to a UK address different to what we hold on our system, please let us know by midday on 21 August 2024. Please note, emails and post will be sent after midday on 22 August.

The nominated person must have the student's permission to collect the results on their behalf. **The named nominee must also bring photo ID for themselves.** We will not release results to third parties under any other circumstances.

Post-16 destination advice

To support students who, at the time of receiving their results, need further advice and guidance with respect to their post-16 destination, there will be staff available to help them on Thursday 22 August 2024 until 12:00pm in the hall.
