Overview

Cranbury College is a Pupil Referral Unit spread over 2 sites: Primary and Secondary. We work with young people with and without diagnosed SEND needs.

We offer a comprehensive 5-day induction programme which allows us to get an insightful look at new students as they arrive. Psychometric testing is part of this programme, along with numerous activities that allow us to get to know the young person better.

A pupil passport is generated from this induction programme which is shared with staff from the start of their journey at Cranbury College and is also shared when they move on.
